What is Family Empowerment Services?

Family Empowerment Services (FES) is a program to enhance the ability of families to provide for their children's well-being in a minimally intrusive and time limited manner.

Who can receive FES?

- The family must live in Philadelphia
- There must be a child under the age of 18, who lives in the home
- There should not be another home-based case management service active with the family

What is the goal of FES?

- Promote family stability and well-being
- Enhance protective factors
- Reduce risk factors for families and children
- Increase community supportive networks and linkages for families and children
- Increase a family's abilities to address their own needs

What can you expect from YSI FES?

- 2 visits per month for up to 3 months of home-based case management support
- At the start of service, and in collaboration with the family, an assessment is conducted to identify strengths and needs. Goals and interventions are also created for service
- A case manager works with the family to meet the goals by connecting the family to resources; advocating for services; and when appropriate, providing informal, in-home supports

What are areas FES can support?

- Basic needs, including employment exploration and money management
- Educational support
- Parenting, parent/child conflict
- Mental health and behavioral health supports
