



- **Description of Service**

- Each eligible youth will receive a FR Service Coordinator, whose main role is to promote timely connections to well-being services and break down barriers to accessing these services. Such well-being services may include but are not limited to behavioral health, housing, education, domestic violence, etc. The FR Service Coordinator will help to navigate and advocate for resources across these informal, community-based providers. CUA workers will retain all of their current casemanagement responsibilities, and the FR Service Coordinator will provide added support to the family (i.e., caregivers and youth) to address well-being concerns and promote timely reunification.

## Family Reunification (FR)

- **Goal of Service**

- Timely reunification for youth entering out-of-home placement for the first time due to well-being issues, such as but not limited to parent/child conflict, truancy, behavioral health, etc.

- **Eligibility Criteria**

- Youth ages 9-17 who are entering placement for the first time.

- **Length of Service**

- FR normally lasts for up to 6 months, unless the child is reunified earlier. Services can be extended if appropriate. The FR Service Coordinator can provide aftercare following reunification for up to 6 weeks.
